

Dickinson County Board of Supervisors
March 12, 2010

11:00 A.M. Present are Supervisors Mardi Allen, Pam Jordan, Wayne Northey, Paul Johnson Vice-Chairperson, and David Gottsche, Chairperson.

Emergency Management, Engineer, and DNR personnel also present. County Engineer explained that the applications for the current culvert project at Lower Gar were sent in January to the DNR. However, the DNR doesn't want to issue the permits until there is an agreement with the City of Milford.

Mike Ehret presented updated information on the water levels of the lakes and updated models. Discussion on the issues stated by Milford: 1. who will do maintenance on the culverts, 2. Environmental issue downstream and 3. An indemnification clause. The Board discussed the possibility of using pumps at the site and found that they could get two pumps to use from Fremont County. Arrangements were made to have the pumps delivered on Monday or Tuesday. The Board reviewed a letter prepared by emergency management to be sent to Governor Culver requesting that advanced measures be taken by the Army Corp of Engineers as follows: 1. Requesting pumping at the Lower Gar Outlet 2. Two box culverts are installed 6 inches above the weir and 3. A controlled breach of the Lower Gar Road. The Board will be meeting with the City of Milford on Monday night to present this letter also, for their approval as well as to discuss the overall project.
