

**Dickinson County Board of Supervisors**  
**June 1, 2010**

9:30 a.m. Present are Supervisors Mardi Allen, Paul Johnson, Vice-Chairperson, Wayne Northey. Absent is David Gottsche and Pam Jordan.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited to open the meeting.

Discussion with Assistant County Attorney concerning the acquisition of railroad right of way property in Dickinson and Osceola Counties for the recreational trails project. Following discussion, it was moved by Allen, seconded by Northey to approve and enter into a joint public service agreement by and between the Dickinson County Board of Supervisors, Osceola County Board of Supervisors, Dickinson County Trails Board and Osceola County Conservation Board to establish the relationship for the purchase, site preparation, construction and maintenance of a Recreation Trail. All present voted aye.

Moved by Northey, seconded by Allen to approve the purchase agreement with the Iowa Natural Heritage Foundation, and Osceola County, Iowa, for approximately 281.6 acres of railroad right of way property for a recreation trail. All present voted aye.

Moved by Northey, seconded by Allen to approve the fireworks display affidavits for Tim Drinkle for July 2 (Lake Park), July 3 (Big Spirit Lake), and July 4 (West Lake Okoboji), 2010. All present voted aye.

Jordan present telephonically. Discussion on a response to City of Okoboji concerning the proposed annexation of property in the Bayrym Area to the City of Okoboji. Allen gave an update on the consultation meeting she attended as presented by the City of Okoboji. Moved by Jordan, seconded by Allen to send a letter to authorize the County Attorney's Office to send a letter to the City of Okoboji stating that the county opposed the proposed annexation of the Bayrym area. Roll call vote: Alley-aye, Jordan-aye, Northey-aye, Johnson-abstained. Gottsche was absent. Motion carried.

County Engineer present. Moved by Northey, seconded by Allen to approve the recommendation to change ½ mile of 190<sup>th</sup> Street, from M27 westerly between sections 21 and 28 of Excelsior Township, from Level B to Level A service. The purpose of this change is to provide access to the wind towers located at 1246 190<sup>th</sup> Street. All present voted aye.

Moved by Northey, seconded by Allen to approve the request for drainage district number 6 repairs to the City of Lake Park outlet in DD 6 located in Section 22 of Silver Lake Township as requested by Vance Hjelm, estimated to be less than \$1000 in cost. All present voted aye.

Moved by Allen, seconded by Northey to approve the request to repair the outlet bulkhead of DD #46 located in Section 19 of Milford Township by Jack Johnson, with the estimated cost to be less than \$1000. All present voted aye.

There being no further items for business presented before the Board, it was moved by Allen, seconded by Northey to adjourn. All voted aye.
