

## **Mental Health Services**

### **Who is eligible for these services?**

You may be eligible to access Dickinson County funding if you are:

- 18 years or older diagnosed with a mental illness
- Without private insurance or funds to pay for services independently
- A legal resident of Dickinson County
- In need of mental health services and service coordination

*Dickinson County will not deny the right to quality care based on sex, race, creed, socioeconomic status, mental or physical disability or impairment.*

### **How are these services accessed?**

You may pick up and complete an application to access Dickinson County funding at the following locations:

- Dickinson County Courthouse/Community Services Office
- Season's Center for Community Mental Health

*You must complete an application and receive service authorization before services are initiated, except in the case of an emergency.*

### **What services are available?**

- In-patient hospitalization
- Outpatient counseling
- 24-hour crisis management
- Case management
- Partial hospitalization/day treatment
- Vocational assessment/support
- Residential and supervised living arrangements
- Assistance with household maintenance
- Evaluation
- Community support services
