

Selection Criteria – Drawing Process

1.
 - For Bow/Archery Season: Two (2) people will be awarded a permit for each Permit Period – this is to mean that during each Permit Period there will be 2 people sharing the “Permissible Hunting Area”.
 - For Youth and Disabled Season: Five (5) people will be awarded a permit for each Permit Period – this is to mean that during each Permit Period, there will be 5 people sharing the “Permissible Hunting Area”.
2. Drawings will be held in sequential order – drawing for Permit Period 1 will be first, drawing for Permit Period 2 will be second, drawing for Permit Period 3 will be third, etc.
3. All requests for applications will include a pre-addressed envelope that applicants should use for application submittal. On the envelope, there is an area for the applicant to mark their choices as to which permit period they wish to apply.
4. Utilizing the applicant’s choice selections, as described above, the DCCB will put all applications for each specific Permit Period into one selection group and will draw out the winners. Those who are not drawn for that Permit Period will be entered into the applicants other choice – no preference is given to the applicant’s choices.
5. In the event of all permits not being filled, the DCCB will put all unselected applications into one (1) drawing and will continue to select applications until all permits are issued, or until no further interest is shown in the periods available from all received applications.
6. For the 2006-07 season, the following are the Permit drawing dates:
 - Youth and Disabled Season – September 8th, 2006
 - Bow/Archery Season – September 22nd, 2006
7. Winning applicants will be notified within three (3) business days of their respective drawing date of being awarded a Permit.
